dry orange wine with bright candied citrus and mediterranean herbs

2024 Cerasuolo d'Abruzzo, De Fermo, 'Concrete Rosato', Italy (Abruzzo) 82

dry, fresh, easy-drinking, floral, deeply colored rosato made from montepulciano grapes

2023 Cabernet Sauvignon, Lovely Creatures, South Africa (Western Cape) .12.

only available by the glass. medium-bodied and brighter than most.

2023 Barbera del Monferrato, Ercole, Italy (Piedmont) 1 liter .15/54.

dry, juicy, bright red fruits, subtle spice, and soft tannins for easy-drinking!

2022 Cabernet Sauvignon, Sister's Run, Australia .15/45.

rich soil, concentrated black fruit, bold tannins, beetroot, and cedar.

2023 Pinot Noir, Hirsch Vineyards, 'The Bohan-Dillon', California (Sonoma) .103.

inspired by burgundian-style winemaking, this single-vineyard pinot noir is vibrant, light-bodied, full of young red fruits, delicate, and much recommended with an aromatic lift of mint. plus, a cute kitty on the bottle!
